Content	<p>The Fitness Club of Mangalmay Institute of Management and Technology (MIMT) hosted an informative session for MBA students on March 28, 2024, in honor of World Tuberculosis Day. Dr. Ajay Pratap Singh, who is the Director of IQAC and a medical professional, conducted the session. Dr. Singh's proficiency in the medical domain enabled him to offer students comprehensive details about tuberculosis (TB), covering its transmission, symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment choices.</p> <p>The workshop intended to accomplish multiple primary goals. The primary goal was to increase students' knowledge of the persistent public health issue of TB. The session aimed to educate attendees on the transmission of TB, enabling them to protect themselves and others. The program empowered students by educating them about symptoms and diagnosis, enabling them to seek help if needed. The seminar aimed to address the stigma surrounding TB in order to promote a more supportive campus atmosphere.</p>
Outcome of	The World Tuberculosis Day awareness program probably resulted in



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Activity	<p>various positive results. Participants acquired a heightened comprehension of tuberculosis, encompassing its transmission, symptoms, and available treatment methods. The event increased knowledge of TB as an ongoing public health issue and potentially decreased stigma associated with the disease. Over time, the event may motivate students to embrace healthy habits that lower the risk of TB and to promptly seek testing or treatment if they display symptoms. The session could motivate student groups or the institute to establish more extensive tuberculosis support and preventive programs. Although direct attendance may have been restricted, participants can still disseminate their learned knowledge, expanding the positive influence beyond the session.</p>
